CUBA

A \$3,500 Eleanor Venture Travel Grant was awarded to Kaarina Demers, an Altona Middle School teacher, who will travel to Cuba with a 10-day cultural immersion, curriculum development program. Upon her return she'll introduce an inspired new unit for Altona's 6th grade Social Studies classes.

KILIMANJARO

Jayne Margolin-Sneider, a Westview Middle School teacher was gifted a \$4,500 travel grant to join an international team of students, teachers and scientist from NASA's GLOBE Program and Discovery Education on a student learning expedition to Mt. Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, Africa. Jayme and the team hosted several live webinars about the science taking place on the mountain viewed by approximately 650,000 students world wide.

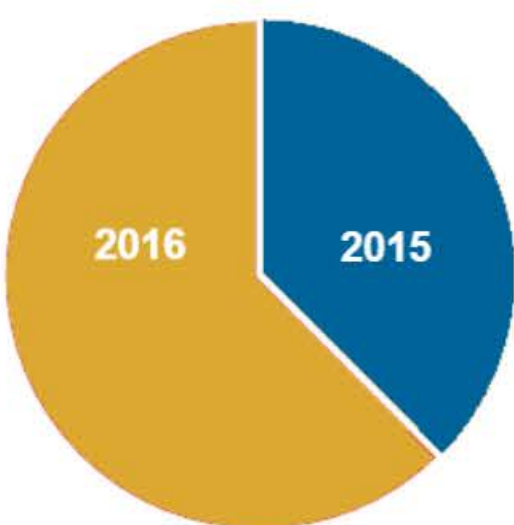

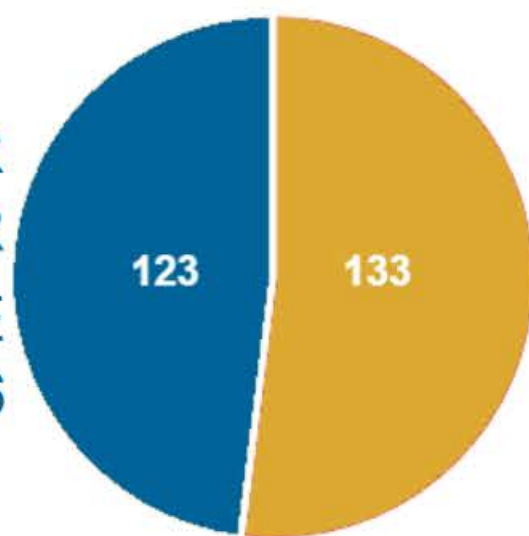
