Larry Sieckmann Memorial Scholarship

Background: Larry Sieckmann was a long time community resident proudly involved in community banking and local civic organizations. He was vitally interested in making the Longmont and Mead area a great place to work and raise children. Larry's family and friends are honoring his memory with this scholarship.

Award: One award of \$1,000 (payable to the recipient's account at the educational institution of choice)

To Be Eligible You Must:

- Be a high school senior attending either Longmont or Mead high school, graduating this year
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, beginning in the fall of this year

Selection Process: The selection committee will consider the applicant's:

- Personal Essay
- High school activities, honors and awards that demonstrate the applicant well-rounded nature
- Volunteer and community service record
- High school transcript(s) for Grade 9 through the first semester of Grade 12
- Letters of Recommendation

Letters of Recommendation: Two (2) letters of recommendation are required.

- One (1) from a teacher, administrator or counselor and
- One (1) from a community member who is not a family member

Application Process: Please complete and provide (1) the application; (2) personal essay; (3) transcript(s); and (4) two letters of recommendation and deliver one copy of each to the counseling office at your high school.

Note: If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included the application will not be considered. Additional materials of any kind will not be considered.

Deadline: Must be delivered to Counseling Office at your school no later than February 28, 2020.
